#6: MUSICAL THEATRE ACTING: BUILDING YOUR BOOK

COST: \$80

Any actor will tell you that one of the key tools in their arsenal is a solid audition book. In this class, students will select four songs from different musical theatre genres, and receive four, one-on-one, thirty minute coaching sessions, where we will work on musical interpretation, and acting through song. At the end of the class, students will have the opportunity to select their

favorite song and perform it in a virtual cabaret for friends and family. This class will meet in person, with social distancing measures in place.

#7: MONOLOGUE WORKSHOP

In the second session of this three part class, students will work to develop their understanding on what makes a well rounded, sympathetic character, and how to write believable dialogue. Students will get the opportunity to have their original open scenes studied and performed by the

directing class, as well as writing their own one act play. While we will be building on skills learned in Playwriting 101, this class is open to anyone with a story to tell! This class will be a hybrid class, taking place in person outside, weather permitting.

Scenic painting is an introduction to the various techniques used to paint sets and faux textures. Throughout this class, you will learn how to paint wood grain, marble, and faux bevels for any surface. As part of the class, you will have the opportunity to apply your skills and help paint BWTC’s set for “The Laramie Project.”

#25: INTRO TO DESIGN

Intro to Design is a class for anyone interested in theatrical design.
